

# Random Quilt

approximately 57" x 75"

Cutting directions:

- 16 - 6" squares, can be fussy cut to center a motif
- 7 - 8" squares, cut diagonally twice, A4, B2, B3, C2
- 4 - 4 1/2" squares, cut diagonally once, A2, A3, C3, C4
- 32 - 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" strips
- 3/4 yd. for sashing and first border, cut into 2 1/2" strips
- 1 3/4 yd. for outside border, cut 5 1/2" and binding

I constructed the quilt by making two of section A, (see diagrams below) 12 of section B, and 2 of section C. Sew the two long strips, measure the length and add a sashing between them and on the outside edges.

Stitch the 2 1/2" strips together, measure and adjust if necessary to fit the already constructed section. Add to the first section and add the sashing strip. Measure the width of the piece and add the top and bottom sashing.

Add the outside borders, quilt and bind.
